Many recent books on Africa (rightly) deal with the history and impact of colonialism. However, there are hardly any books about the socio-economic future of Africa. This book refers to the colonial past to understand the present, but focuses on the future, especially the next thirty years. The interest in the Dutch-language version of the book has demonstrated that readers from the Western world aspire to gain insight into the continent's future.

The book does away with pessimistic mainstream stereotypes about Africa (misery, hunger, war, etc.). It throws a positive and optimistic light on the continent's potential. The time has come for a new vision of Africa.

The book describes the future using a unique mix of robust economic analysis and on-the-ground experience. The real-life stories make the book easy to read.
