Taking recent spectacular progress in AI fully into account, this book explores prospects for artificial literary translation and composition, with frequent reference to the hyperconscious literary art of Vladimir Nabokov. The exploration balances reader-friendly explanation ("What are transformers?") and original insights ("What is intelligence? What is language?") with personal and playful notes, and culminates in an assortment of striking demos.

This volume first explores the potential of machine translation of literature; goes on to explore possibilities for artificial literary creation; and finishes by assessing recent spectacular progress in generative artificial intelligence (AI) – throughout, with reference to Vladimir Nabokov's hyperconscious literary art.

### Readership

The boom in current interest in artificial intelligence should boost acquisition by a wide reader base on both sides of the culture gap – by the many readers interested in artificial intelligence and translation on one side, and by devotees of literature on the other. The approach should be sufficiently popular and inviting for sale in general bookstores (brick and online), but sufficiently solid and defensible to be read and discussed in academic circles.
